

How to use {smartassembly} command line mode?

The console application is in the same folder than {smartassembly}.exe, usually in *C:\Program Files\{smartassembly}\{smartassembly}.com*

The usage is {smartassembly}.com [switch] [projectfile | assemblyfile | reportfile]

The available switches are:

/build myproject.{sa}proj

This will build the specified project. The project must be previously created in the GUI mode of {smartassembly}.

/markasreleased myassembly.exe

This will mark the map associated as released. It has the same effect as clicking the 'Mark as Released' button once you build your project in the GUI mode of {smartassembly}.

/addreport myencryptedreport.{sa}encryptedreport

With the SDK (Enterprise Edition only), the end-user can decide to save the report locally, and send it to you per email).

When you get the encrypted report file, you can either dbl-click the file (if it has the correct *.{sa}encryptedreport* extension) or run this command line option. In both cases, the report will be added to the database, as if it was downloaded from the web-service.

/compactdb

This will compact {smartassembly} database ({smartassembly}\{database}.mdb).
